PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- Only students who are Baldwin Residents and attend public, private or parochial schools may register for the Secondary Summer Program with appropriate written approval from their school administration including proof of guardianship as well as a description of the course they wish to register for.
- All questions concerning residency will be determined by the District Office in accordance with current policy. In order to register for the Baldwin Secondary Summer School all registrants MUST present the following:
 1. 2 Proofs of Residency (Utility Bill, Drivers License*, Lease etc.)
 2. \$3.00 Registration Fee
 3. School Identification Card
 4. Proof that all outstanding fines have been paid in full
 5. All texts have been returned

*Parents MUST show NYS Identification upon registration – NO EXCEPTIONS

- Registration in person is available for all and is required for students with outstanding fines or fees. No telephone or mail-in registration is permitted.
- **Submission of ALL enrollment forms and the complete payment of all fees must be made at the time of registration either by cash or certified check only. Fees are non-refundable as of July 6th, 2010.**

SUMMER SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Attendance will be strictly enforced so that credit is earned in compliance with New York State Education Department regulations. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Requirements for Receiving Course Credit

1. 25 days minimum attendance (Regents Level).
2. Tardiness of *fewer* than 15 minutes is counted as ½ of an absence.
3. Tardiness of *more* than 15 minutes is counted as 1 absence.
4. THERE ARE NO EXCUSED ABSENCES!
5. Students with more than 2 absences in a Regents course or 3 absences in a non-Regents course will be dropped from the Secondary Summer Program.
6. Class participation (quizzes, behavior, homework, notebooks, classroom work, major tests, etc.) will be factored into the final grade.

Code of Conduct

1. The Administration of Baldwin Summer School enforces a zero tolerance policy towards violence and drugs. Any student whose behavior is determined to be violent, involved with weapons of any kind, or in violation of Civil or Criminal law, will be dropped from the program. This behavior includes, but is not limited to assault/battery, possession, use or transfer of drugs or dangerous weapons, arson, extortion, bomb threats, vandalism, theft, possession or sale of stolen property, causing a false fire alarm, cyber bullying and sexual harassment. Penalties may also include arrest. Anyone observing or being victimized by such an act should report this information to a teacher, a staff member, Mr. Caballero or Mr. White.
2. Electronic devices are not permitted in school and will be confiscated.
3. Students must dress appropriately for class; bare feet are not permitted.
4. Loitering is not permitted on school grounds at any time.
5. Smoking is strictly prohibited on school grounds.
6. All bicycles are required to be locked to the bicycle rack located at the 600 building entrance.
7. School I.D. cards must be shown in order to enter the building. NO EXCEPTIONS! Failure to do so may result in being sent home.
